- 1. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance
 - Led by Joe Lawrence, including prayers for those in need and for guidance in the new year.
- 2. Call to Order
 - Meeting called to order at 5:03 PM by John Marinko.
- 3. Approval of Agenda

- 4. Welcome Guests Public Input
 - Dennis Berry discussed concerns about the lack of night approaches, highlighting the
 economic impact on business aviation. He shared an example of a perfect autopilot landing,
 underscoring the frustration with current FAA delays.
 - Gabe Chatam provided updates on their hangar project, noting they're close to receiving a Certificate of Occupancy (CO). They requested an extension of their lease to at least 30 years, ideally 40, due to increased construction costs.
